CHILDCARE RELIEF WORKER

This is a flexible on-call position facilitating childcare in our Community Advocacy Program and our Home Safe Program.

RESPONSIBILITY: Providing childcare, homework group and family fun nights for children whose families have experienced domestic violence.

REPORTS TO: Program Managers

HOURS: Hours vary, but shift length is generally between 2 to 3 hours. All shifts are scheduled in advance. There are day and evening shifts at various North Seattle locations.

COMPENSATION: \$16.00 per hour; paid training opportunities; sick leave, retirement contributions.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for ensuring a safe and secure environment while providing childcare for children at New Beginnings
- Implement activities and provide guidance for childcare, homework group, and other activities
- Incorporate trauma informed best practices into their work with parents and their children
- Find own coverage if unable to work a shift
- Other duties as assigned

REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to exercise flexibility and creativity in supporting children and youth
- Ability to work with diverse survivors in a welcoming, supportive, culturally competent manner
- Ability to maintain participant confidentiality
- Experience with childcare

OTHER:

- Maintains cleanliness and supplies at New Beginnings childcare sites
- Report concerns regarding children's safety as well as other relevant information to children's advocate
- Communicate via incident report all relevant information regarding situations, incidents and children's behavior on your shift (positive and negative). Follow up with children's advocate on duty
