YOUTH AND FAMILY ADVOCATE RELIEF WORKER (On-Call)

People of color, survivors of domestic violence encouraged to apply.

RESPONSIBILITY: Providing childcare, homework groups and family fun nights for children whose families have experienced domestic violence.

REPORTS TO: Program Managers

HOURS: Hours vary. Shift lengths are between 2 and 4 hours. All shifts are scheduled in advance (day and evening shifts at various Seattle locations). Availability on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Evenings desired.

COMPENSATION: \$15.50 per hour

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for ensuring a safe and secure environment while providing childcare for children at New Beginnings sites.
- Implement creative activities and offer guidance for childcare, homework group, and other activities.
- Find own coverage from the on-call roster if unable to work scheduled shift.
- Other duties as assigned.

OTHER

- Maintain cleanliness of childcare spaces and toys.
- Report concerns regarding children's safety as well as other relevant information to the advocate on duty or the Program Manager.
- Communicate via incident report all relevant information regarding situations, incidents and children's behavior on your shift (positive and negative).

REQUIREMENTS

- Prior experience with childcare.
- Experience working with traumatized children.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- An ability to work effectively with diverse individuals, groups and communities.
