HOURS:

Community events as needed (daytime and evening events)

LOCATION: Greater Seattle area

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

New Beginnings provides services to those whose lives have been affected by domestic violence - physical, emotional, or sexual abuse. Some who use our services are in physical danger. Others are living with controlling partners in relationships that are emotionally abusive. In this position, you will assist the development and social change departments to educate the larger Seattle community to understand more about this epidemic. As a tabling & outreach volunteer, you will be responsible to:

- ✓ Represent New Beginnings at outreach events throughout Seattle area in partnership with other volunteers & the Community Engagement Coordinator.
- ✓ Improve outreach materials and update outreach bag as needed.
- ✓ Strategize ways to engage more broadly in the Seattle community
- ✓ Provide feedback about events, community resources, and connections made during outreach opportunities

REQUIREMENTS: Becoming a volunteer at New Beginnings is a rewarding and engaging experience that requires a serious commitment. Requirements include:

- ✓ Commitment to supporting the work & mission of New Beginnings
- ✓ Respect of others' individual choices and values
- ✓ An interest to be part of social change efforts
- ✓ Public speaking experience
- ✓ Excellent organizational skills
- ✓ Willingness to share ideas and create new ways of engaging the community
